A READING FROM THE ACTS OF THE APOSTLES

LITURGICAL NOTES - WHAT IS A LITURGICAL OCTAVE? The term is taken from the Latin word "octo" meaning "eight" or "octavus" meaning "eighth". In our Church's liturgical calendar some Solemnities are considered to be so important in the truths they convey, that they are celebrated for eight days in succession. Such it is for the Solemnity of Pentecost. You will notice by the week's liturgical schedule of Masses, that the joyous mystery of the sending of the Holy Spirit and His manifold gifts upon the fledgling Church, will be celebrated for eight consecutive days, superseding any other liturgical commemorations and ending with the celebration of the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity on next Sunday. These Masses are referred to as "Masses of the Octave."
