**A READING FROM THE SECOND BOOK OF KINGS**

One day Elisha came to Shunem, where there was a woman of influence, who urged him to dine with her. Afterward, whenever he passed by, he used to stop there to dine. So she said to her husband, "I know that Elisha is a holy man of God. Since he visits us often, let us arrange a little room on the roof and furnish it for him with a bed, table, chair, and lamp, so that when he comes to us he can stay there." We were indeed buried with him through baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might live in newness of life. If, then, we have died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him. We know that Christ, raised from the dead, dies no more; death no longer has power over him. As to his death, he died to sin once and for all; as to his life, he lives for God.**

Consequently, you too must think of yourselves as dead to sin and living for God in Christ Jesus.

**LITURGICAL NOTES:** Deacons of our Church will be servicing the parish throughout the month of July. The Diaconate is an ordained ministry, which shares to a degree in the sacramental priesthood of Jesus Christ. To this end deacons may proclaim the Holy Gospel, perform Benediction, preach and (in the absence of a priest), preside at certain public, liturgical functions of the Church. They may also distribute Holy Communion to the faithful under certain circumstances. Deacons however, do not have the sacramental power to celebrate Holy Mass and confect the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist. This function is reserved for a validly ordained priest or bishop, whose power to change bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ flows from their higher degree of ordination which grafts them sacramentally into the fullness of the High Priesthood of Jesus Christ of which a bishop shares most fully. Therefore we should not refer to the Service led by a deacon as a "Mass." as there is no such thing as a "Deacon's Mass" (or even more so), a "Lay Mass." The term "Mass" only denotes the Eucharistic Sacrifice offered by a priest or bishop "in persona Christi," that is, in the very person of Christ by virtue of priestly ordination. So then, the deacons coming to serve at our parish are not celebrating the Mass, but instead leading a service of the Word of God with distribution of Holy Communion, which will be consecrated at today's Mass by Fr. Mikula. The office of Deacon then, is one of humble service. Our church is blessed to have wonderful deacons who give generously of their time and efforts in building the Body of Christ, which is His Church. Please welcome them as they come to serve.
