A READING FROM THE LETTER OF ST. PAUL TO THE EPHESIANS

Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for that is what is expected of you. "Honor your father and mother" is the first commandment to carry a promise with it "that it may go well with you, and that you may have long life on earth."

Fathers, do not anger your children. Bring them up with the training and instruction befitting the Lord.

Slaves, obey your human masters with the reverence, the awe, and the sincerity you owe to Christ. Do not render service for appearance only to please men, but do God's will with your whole heart as slaves of Christ. Give your service willingly, doing it for the Lord rather than men. You know that each one, whether slave or free, will be repaid by the Lord for whatever good he does.

Masters, act in a similar way toward your slaves. Stop threatening them. Remember that you and they have a Master in heaven who plays no favorites.

A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO ST. LUKE

The parents of Jesus used to go every year to Jerusalem for the feast of the Passover, and when He was twelve they went up for the celebration as was their custom. As they were returning at the end of the feast, the Child Jesus remained behind unknown to His parents. Thinking He was in the party, they continued their journey for a day, looking for Him among their relatives and acquaintances.

Not finding Him, they returned to Jerusalem in search of Him. On the third day they came upon Him in the temple sitting in the midst of the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions. And all who heard him were amazed at His intelligence and His answers. When His parents saw Him they were astonished, and His mother said to Him: "Son, why have You done this to us? You see that your father and I have been searching for You in sorrow."

He said to them: "WHY DID YOU SEARCH FOR ME? DID YOU NOT KNOW I HAD TO BE IN MY FATHER'S HOUSE?" But they did not grasp what He said to them. He went down with them then, and came to Nazareth, and was obedient to them. His mother meanwhile kept all these things in memory. Jesus for His part, progressed steadily in wisdom and age and grace before God and men.
