All, from least to greatest, shall know Me, says the Lord, for I will forgive their evil-doing and remember their sins no more.

A READING FROM THE FIRST LETTER OF ST. JOHN

God he has not seen. The commandment from Him is this: "Whoever loves God must also love his brother."

A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO ST. LUKE

On one occasion a lawyer stood up to posed this problem to Jesus: "Teacher, what must I do to inherit everlasting life?" Jesus, answered him: "WHAT IS WRITTEN IN THE LAW? HOW DO YOU READ IT?" He replied, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself."

Jesus said, "YOU HAVE ANSWERED CORRECTLY. DO THIS AND YOU SHALL LIVE."

But because he wished to justify himself he said to Jesus, "And who is my neighbor?"

HE THEN HOISTED HIM ON HIS OWN BEAST AND BROUGHT HIM TO AN INN, WHERE HE CARED FOR HIM. THE NEXT DAY HE TOOK OUT TWO SILVER PIECES AND GAVE THEM TO THE INNKEEPER WITH THE REQUEST: 'Look after him, and if there is any further expense I will repay you on my way back.' WHICH OF THESE THREE, IN YOUR OPINION, WAS NEIGHBOR TO THE MAN WHO FELL IN WITH THE ROBBERS?"

The answer came, "The one who treated him with compassion." Jesus said to him, "THEN GO AND DO THE SAME."
