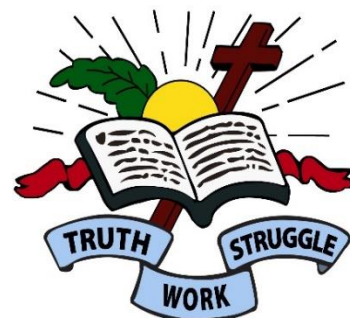

Second Sunday of Lent

A Sabbath Thought

The lesson of Lent is that deliverance comes only through transformation. Untold blessings and bountiful peace shall follow today's trials for those reborn in God's image.

About Today's Bible Readings

GENESIS 15:5-12, 17-18

God is faithful. This God commands our homage and showers untold blessings on those who are faithful in turn.

Responsorial Psalm: 27:1, 7-8, 8-9, 13-14

R. The Lord is my light and my salvation.

PHILIPPIANS 3:17-4:1

The cross of Christ should rule the lives of believers. In the end, glory awaits those who are imitators of Christ.

LUKE 9:28B-36

On the mountain, Jesus' appearance changes radically. But the disciples are changed too because they have seen the glory of the Lord.

THE GOSPEL (LUKE 9:28B-36)

Jesus took Peter, John, and James and went up the mountain to pray. While he was praying his face changed in appearance and his clothing became dazzling white. And behold, two men were conversing with him, Moses and Elijah, who appeared in glory and spoke of his exodus that he was going to accomplish in Jerusalem. Peter and his companions had been overcome by sleep, but becoming fully awake, they saw his glory and the two men standing with him. As they were about to part from him, Peter said to Jesus, "Master, it is good that we are here; let us make three tents, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." But he did not know what he was saying. While he was still speaking, a cloud came and cast a shadow over them, and they became frightened when they entered the cloud. Then from the cloud came a voice that said, "This is my chosen Son; listen to him." After the voice had spoken, Jesus was found alone. They fell silent and did not at that time tell anyone what they had seen.
