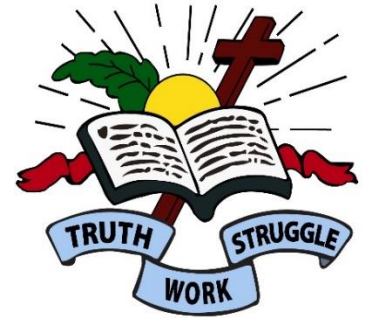

#### ACTS 15:1-2, 22-29

In an atmosphere of dissension and controversy, Paul reaches out to people who need care. He gives them his presence and urges them to focus on what is essential.

**R. O God, let all the nations praise you!**

#### REVELATION

21:10-14, 22-23

This is what it will be like at the end, says John the seer: a city whose light will be God. What we dream *now* will be reality *then*.

#### JOHN 14:23-29

Be true to my word, says Jesus, and God will dwell in you through the Spirit.

The Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you. Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give it to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid. You heard me tell you, ‘I am going away and I will come back to you.’ If you loved me, you would rejoice that I am going to the Father; for the Father is greater than I. And now I have told you this before it happens, so that when it happens you may believe.”
