Gospel JN 6:51-58

A reading from the Holy Gospel according to John.

Jesus said to the Jewish crowds: "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world." The Jews quarreled among themselves, saying, "How can this man give us his flesh to eat?" Jesus said to them, "Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day. For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him. Just as the living Father sent me and I have life because of the Father, so also the one who feeds on me will have life because of me. This is the bread that came down from heaven. Unlike your ancestors who ate and still died, whoever eats this bread will live forever."

Corpus Christi is the celebration of the abiding presence of the loving God as Emmanuel – God-with-us – in order to give collective thanks to our Lord living with us in the Eucharist. The feast gives us an occasion to learn more about the importance and value of his "Real Presence," so that we may appreciate the Sacrament better and receive maximum benefit from receiving Jesus in Holy Communion.

BIBLE READINGS EX 34:4B-6, 8-9

Moses instructs the Israelites to "remember and not forget" the miraculous provision of food in the manna given to them to save their lives in the desert.

Responsorial Psalm R. Praise the Lord, Jerusalem.

2 COR 13:11-13

Paul reminds the Corinthians that the Bread they share is the real Body of Christ, which makes their community also the Body of the risen Christ.

JN 3:16-18

Jesus identifies himself as "the Living Bread that came down from Heaven," thus linking himself with the manna in the wilderness, while assuring his disciples that, unlike those who ate manna, "One who eats this Bread will live forever."

OUR CHURCHE WILL BE RE-OPEN ON SUNDAY, JUNE 21

New Jersey churches, synagogues, mosques, and other houses of worship may reopen to indoor services with larger capacity limits after months of restrictions to slow the spread of the coronavirus, Gov. Phil Murphy announced Tuesday, June 9.

Religious institutions are included in a new executive order that increases the limits on indoor gatherings in the state from 10 to 50 people or 25% or a building's capacity — whichever is lower — effective immediately. People must also wear face coverings and stand six feet apart.

Theoretically we could open Our Savior this Sunday, but we will be waiting still one more week until our church is ready to meet all the requirements (disinfection of pews, doors, bathrooms etc.) Please participate in the Mass online from St. Valentine's at 9:30 this Sunday.

Next Sunday, June 21, on Father's Day, we invite you to Our Saviour church for the Mass for fathers.
