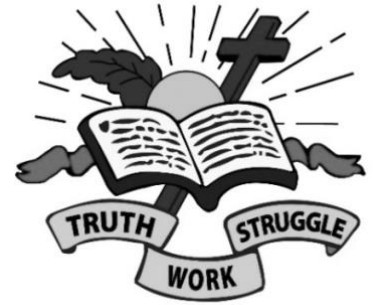

Pentecost Sunday

FAITH SHARING

On the day of Pentecost the Holy Spirit descended upon the apostles and the Blessed Virgin Mary as fiery tongues. The frightened apostles were transformed into fiery preachers and evangelizers and were given the gift of tongues by a special anointing of the Holy Spirit. The listeners experienced a fresh anointing of the Holy Spirit through the apostles' gift of tongues: they heard Peter speaking in their native languages. The early Christians became powerful witnesses and brave martyrs for their Faith in Jesus.



We need to permit the Holy Spirit to take control of our lives:
by constantly remembering His holy presence and behaving well;
by praying for His daily anointing so that we may fight against our temptations and control our evil tendencies, evil habits and addictions;
by asking His daily assistance to pray, listening to God through meditative Bible reading, and talking to Him; and
by asking the help of the Holy Spirit to do good for others and to be reconciled with God and others every day.

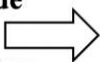
