LENTEN OBSERVANCE: Lent begins with Ash Wednesday, which is this Wednesday. The Lenten Observance means fasting and abstaining. **FASTING** giving up certain pleasures during this time. **ABSTAINING** means not eating meat on certain days of Lent. This Wednesday is a day of fast and abstaining along with Good Friday. These rules apply to persons age 7 to 70. Those of us who are over 70 can find other means to observe Lent. Sundays do not count in the rules of Lent. Those who are ill or care for the sick are exempt, along with pregnant women. The Lenten discipline ends on Easter Sunday Morning. Easter is April 5th.

WORRY: Today Jesus tells us not worry. We are told not to worry about things we cannot do anything about. A big worry we all have is about money. Do we have enough to do what we want in life.
