LAZARUS: The Gospel tells us of two men who were named Lazarus. The first was a poor man who was ignored by a rich man. Both died and Lazarus went to heaven the rich man did not. The other was the brother of Mary & Martha. He too was wealthy but lived a generous life. Jesus often visited Lazarus and his sisters. Mary was the one who anointed Jesus' feet.

Lazarus had become ill, and word was sent to Jesus to come and help him. But Jesus waited four days. Lazarus' sister Mary said to Jesus, if he had been there her brother would not have died. Jesus told her that her brother would rise again. Mary said yes, on the last day. Jesus told her He was the resurrection and the life. She said she beveled that. Jesus went and resuscitated Lazarus back to life.

What is the difference between Lazarus being brought back and Jesus rising from the dead? With Lazarus it was temporary, he would die again someday. Jesus' Resurrection was His rising after His death to give eternal life to everyone. The key is beveling that Jesus is the resurrection and the life. To believe and trust in this is the way to life with God. The question then is the same to us. Do you believe this?
